Van Kervel School

Special education needs

Intellectually challenged children who experience barriers in reading/writing and numeracy. Emphasis placed on skills and vocational learning such as panel beating, spray painting, vehicle repairs, carpentry, welding, building and maintenance, hospitality studies, office administration and hair dressing. Parallel medium school.

Admission:

Learners are identified by their principals, teachers, parents and school psychologist in a multi-disciplinary team. They can be from a normal primary or high school where they have reached a point where the mainstream education will not meet their special needs. Criteria for admission are the following:

Between the age of 14 years and 16 years “on entry” into special education.

In Grade 7 and functioning on at least a Grade 5 in reading, writing and maths; Grade 6 learners functioning on Grade 4 level in exceptional cases only.

Application should be made via the school psychologist before August of the previous year. The necessary forms can be obtained at the school where the learner is at present or from the local EMDC. The learner must be assessed by the school psychologist and the parents must give written permission for this. A multi-disciplinary team will decide on placement of the learner and this must be confirmed by the WCED

Carpe Diem School

Parallel medium co-ed school for physical- and mentally impaired learners. Admission policy online

Carpe Diem School provides for:

The school provides for physical-, specific learning- and intellectually impaired learners between the ages of 6 and 18 years, who cannot be accommodated in mainstream education. The school also serves a few hearing-impaired learners capable of functioning in a normal class situation with the help of hearing aids and/or FM systems. In the ASD Unit the school also provides for learners on the autistic spectrum. From January 2020 the school also provides for deaf learners from the ages 3-8years in a separate unit with the aim to teach them South African Sign Language

The school serves all towns and farming communities along the Southern Cape coastal region, which include: Riversdale, Albertinia, Mossel Bay, Hartenbos, Klein Brakrivier, Groot Brakrivier, George, Hoekwil, Sedgefield, Karatara, Knysna, Plettenberg Bay and The Craggs.

The medium of education is English and Afrikaans. At this moment there are 343 learners in the school, 84 of these learners are also being cared for in the hostels.

Carpe Diem School curriculum

Learners follow the Curriculum and Assessment Policy (CAPS) & the Differentiated Curriculum Assessment Policy (D:CAPS) as prescribed by the Educational Department, molded to the specific needs of each learner.

Curriculum for learners with Intellectual Impairment

Teachers spend ample time and effort to break down the learning outcomes and assessment standards of the D:CAPS curriculum for learners in the SID (Severely Intellectual Disability) Phase, ensuring that all learners develop their skills and ability optimally in concurrence with their capabilities to achieve a sense of success. The focus is on literacy, numeracy, life orientation and independence rather than knowledge.

Senior learners in this phase's curriculum become more practically orientated, thus focusing more on skills like:

Gardening, maintenance, painting, growing vegetables, wood sanding, pottery and car washing (boys). Cooking, beadwork, mosaic, knitting, cleaning, pottery and auxiliary health This equips learners to join the labor market or one of the local protective workshops in the area, once they reach 18years of age.

Curriculum for learners with Learning Impairment (SLD)

Learners in the SLD Unit (Specific, Learning Disability), with normal intellectual abilities with accompanying learning difficulties, unable to cope in main stream schools, are catered for in this phase. They follow the CAPS curriculum molded to their specific needs.

They will benefit from the smaller class groups, individual attention, amanuensis and voice recording of study material.

Curriculum for learners on the autistic spectrum

At this moment there are 4 classes in the unit. Two caters for the younger learners, one for the higher functioning learners and one for the lower functioning learners. The curriculum focuses on structure, routine and total communication (Makaton, photos, pictures and spoken language). Learners without language are being taught to use PECS (Picture Exchange Communication System) and hand signing. All the classes are equipped with work stations where learners follow the TEACCH (Treatment and Education of Autistic and Related Communication-Handicapped Children - www.autismweb.com/teacch.htm) method of individual learning and practicing of skills.

The sensory aspects and needs of each learner are constantly monitored and considered. A play area and sensory room accommodating their specific need are available. These learners are supported to attend assembly and participate in school activities like concert etc. to help them with the necessary socialization.

Procedure of referral

Learners must be referred to the school by the local EMDC (Educational Management District Centre). Potential learners are evaluated by the school's multi-disciplinary team. The team is responsible to confirm that the learner will benefit from the help and education the school offers, before determining placement in a suitable class. There is a waiting list for some classes.
